Our committee at work



The following has been undertaken in the last few months:

- Work has continued with Club Builder who are assisting us with formulating our Strategic Plan and how to implement it.
- New drag mats have been purchased for synthetic grass courts 7, 8 and 9. These mats
 are ideal for clearing leaves and evenly distributing sand across the court. We kindly
 ask all members to drag the court after use to help preserve the longevity of these
 courts. Blue leaf bins have been provided to place leaves and debris in. There is also a
 rake on each court.
- The synthetic grass courts 7, 8 and 9 have had maintenance work undertaken in November where the sand base was topped up, debris removed from the surface.
- A large tree has been removed by Kingston Council from just outside our boundary fence on court 1. This tree was causing debris on the court and also contributing to pushing the soil forward to the fenceline.
- A new garden bed wall has been installed to replace the rotting boards located at the bottom of the balcony stairs at the rear of the club.
- In celebration of Victoria's Seniors Festival a Seniors Day was held in October. This was a free session of tennis for seniors to join in with our Senior Social group and enjoy some tennis and socialisation.
- The leaking drinking fountain outside the downstairs clubrooms was fixed by Kingston Council.
- We held a week of tennis for This Girl Can campaign.
- A Christmas Social was held on Sunday 1 December which was a great club event of tennis, socialisation and Christmas cheer. After 2 sets the rain came down and we reverted to socialising and a Christmas drink before chicken and salads were enjoyed.
- A hard rubbish collection was held in November and many unused and broken items left the premises.
- The wooden fence on the outside of courts 1&2 and 3&4 which was storm damaged, has been replaced by Kingston Council.
- The wire mesh fence at the bottom of the rear stairs has been replaced by Kingston Council.
- Drains are regularly being cleared by Kingston Council as they block with dirt, en tout cas and leaves during storms. Kingston Council is determining the best way to solve this problem long term.
- A new BBQ has been purchased for use upstairs.
